

## CALL FOR ART: 2023 ART EXHIBIT WITH EMERITI HOUSE AND IURA

The opening reception of the 20<sup>th</sup> (!) annual art exhibit at Emeriti House is **Friday, April 28, 5:00-7:00 pm**. Artwork must be submitted by April 24. **This is your invitation to submit artwork.**

**Eligibility for submission:** The annual exhibit is a partnership between Emeriti House and the IU Retirees Association. Emeriti House retirees, their spouses or partners, and IURA members, their spouses or partners are eligible to submit artwork. Artwork may have been completed at any time (need not be 2023).

**Artwork:** All media of visual art are welcome: painting, photography, prints, drawings, collage, relief or freestanding sculpture, pottery, woodwork, glass, fiber arts, mobiles, digital photo frames (silent), hybrid... (Multimedia/video work might be difficult: if interested, contact us, we'll talk). Past shows have displayed a delightful range of materials, subjects, and size.

### Schedule:

- \* Submit work **in person at Emeriti House**, a) **Monday, April 24, 9:00-11:00 a.m.** or b) **Thursdays and Fridays, 8:30-12 and 1-5, beginning April 6**. Parking vouchers for the parking garage will be provided. There is limited parking behind Emeriti House if needed for carrying awkward objects; we can help you carry, and will have a hand truck.
- \* **Installation will begin at noon on April 24:** works cannot be accepted after that time.
- \* **Opening reception Friday, 28 April, 5:00-7:00 pm** (catered). Everyone is welcome – bring guests!
- \* **Works remain on view for a year**, until the next exhibit is installed, and may be picked up on a loose schedule to be announced at that time.

### Guidelines for submitting art:

- \* *Individuals may submit **up to 2 works***. We plan to represent each artist, exhibiting all works that follow the guidelines below. If space does not permit exhibiting 2 works by each person, the organizing committee will select according to space and other considerations. Each person is assured of at least 1 work in the exhibit.
- \* *Art should be submitted **ready to be exhibited***: attach *hanging hardware* to the back of work to be wall-hung; include *plate holders* as needed for pottery, glassware, flat woodwork, etc; *freestanding 3-D work should be stable* on its own or provided with a base as needed. We will not display works on paper flat on tables.
- \* *The **Art Info Form available at [iura.indiana.edu/artinfoform.docx](http://iura.indiana.edu/artinfoform.docx) must be submitted with each work***, completed in advance if possible to facilitate check-in; forms will be available on-site if you can't print in advance. This form is the basis of the printed label for each object. *Notes:* We've added two optional lines: a) to identify your *pre-retirement university home*, and b) to *briefly (15-word max) comment* on your work: details about a scene, special challenge in making the work, how long it took to make (people often wonder), etc.
- \* *Also, **on the back (or bottom) of each work, attach contact ID: last name, phone/email, title of work.***
- \* *Finally, a **"yellow stickie" with just your last name and the title of the work***, stuck to the front – this will help us match labels to works once the works are installed. We'll have stickie pads at Emeriti House.
